With more than 37 years of experience in audiology, Ann-Marie Hennessey has been with Mass. Eye and Ear for 28 years. She started her professional career in New York City working for the Lexington School for the Deaf. She managed a mobile hearing van that visited senior centers, health fairs, and completed annual hearing testing for the Yeshiva Parochial school systems in all five boroughs. In 1989, she returned to her New England roots and joined Mass. Eye and Ear when cochlear implants were first coming into the market.
